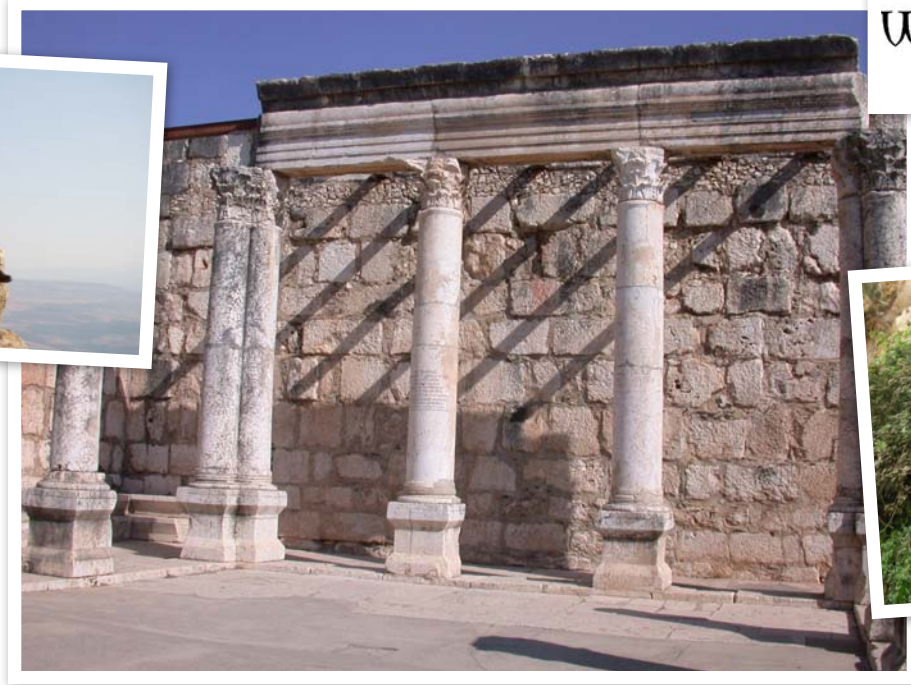

Each day is spent entirely in the field. Most sites are impossible to reach without considerable walking or climbing. Participants should expect to hike 6 miles a day over rocky and hilly terrain in extreme heat. Participants should prepare accordingly.
